

Credential Quality Improvement Awards

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Maine Roads to Quality Professional Development Network (MRTQ PDN) is partnering with the Maine Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child and Family Services (DHHS, OCFS) to offer \$650 Credential Quality Improvement Awards for individuals who earn a Maine Credential between January 1, 2024, and October 31, 2025

Purpose:

To recognize and reward individuals for earning a Maine Credential, focusing their training, coursework, and professional experience on a specific age group or population. Currently, Maine has 6 Credentials including:

- Infant Toddler Credential,
- Youth Development Credential,
- Director Credential.
- Technical Assistance Credential.
- Family Child Care Credential, and
- Inclusion Credential

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive a Credential Quality Improvement Award, an individual must:

- Be an active Member of the MRTQ Registry.
- Complete all requirements of the Credential process and be awarded a Credential before October 31, 2025.
- Be approved to receive payment through the University of Maine System

Participants who earn a Director or Family Child Care Credential and work for or own a program with a Conditional Child Care license, will not be eligible to receive a Quality Improvement Award. Upon resolution of the conditional license, the participant may receive the award, depending on available funds.

Funding

Eligible individuals will receive a \$650 award plus reimbursement for the Credential application fee. Funding for the Credential Quality Improvement Awards is available on a first come, first served basis until October 31, 2025, or until funds are exhausted.
